218

Although a 6-Point, he has no tine length, 2.5-year old satellite bull in most units, may be a herd bull in OTC units. Scores about 218.



330

6-Point, good tine length, long tops--a shooter in OTC units. Will score well at 330.



215

Young Satellite Bull, only a 5x5. Needs one more year till he's P&Y. Scores 215.



308

A Respectable 6-Point with nice tops. This one's a shooter and approximately 4 1/2 years old. We scored him 308.



250

Appears to be a 6x7 with medium tine length. A young bull with great potential - but not a shooter right now. 250 inches.



268

A 6-Point, tough to score at a distance, but both brow & sword tines are on the short side. Three-year-old bull at 268.



295

Nice 6-point, nice swords too! Still looks healthy, must not have rutted too hard. Score=295



275

Small 6-Point with short main beams and short 5ths. Makes book at 275 but needs another year or two to be exceptional.



268

Short & stubby 6-point, he's a low scorer with no tine length and no more than 3.5 years old. Just makes PY minimum at 268.



270

Nice 5-Point, good-looking genes, he'll be a good bull in 2-3 years. Nice long tops - 270.
